Environmental Policy

Environmental Management

With the company continually evolving, we recognise that our operations have an effect on the local, regional and global environment. We ensure that all staff are trained in our Environmental Management Policy and given guidance in its implementation. Our systems are reviewed regularly, to ensure continued development within the company.

The Management is committed to continuous improvements in the environmental performance and the prevention of pollution. Stephen Foster (Health & Safety Advisor) is responsible for the implementation and monitoring of this Environmental Policy with the support from Ellie Core (Director).

Environmental Performance

Current environmental regulations, Laws and Codes of Practice will be regarded as setting the minimum standards of environmental performance.

We will implement measures to help the business and all its employees to use "Green Transport",

For Example: -

- Providing facilities for cyclists
- Encouraging car share
- Encouraging the use of public transport
- Providing information on new forms of energy
- Providing information on new systems of work

Disposal of Waste

We will dispose of all waste in a responsible manner, ensuring that we always comply with the Duty of Care Regulations. Any services used for the storage or disposal of waste will be checked to ensure that appropriate licenses are held.

All waste material will be disposed of at a Licensed Waste Disposal company.

Breaches of Environmental Legislation

Should any notice or prosecution related to a breach of environmental legislation be served against the business by the Environment Agency, a local authority or another regulatory body, we will immediately notify the required bodies and provide full details of the incident.

Reducing Emissions

Where possible we will aim to reduce or eliminate the use of ozone depleting chemicals (CFC, Halon, HCFC etc.).

Sustainable materials will be used wherever possible. Tropical hardwood from forests which have not been independently certified as sustainable will not be used.

Pesticides on the UK 'Red List' or EC 'Black List' and peat for soil amelioration purposes will not be used.

We will try, where possible, to use suppliers who are willing to take away packaging for re-use or recycling and will consider the environmental impact of any purchases.

We will try to reduce the energy and water consumption of the business and minimise CO² emissions. We will invest in improved energy efficiency of products we use and investigate environmentally safe and sustainable energy sources.

We will try to reduce waste production and carry out recycling as much as possible.

Dust and Noise Reduction

We will ensure that dust, noise and odour do not cause a nuisance to the community surrounding the place of business or site on which we are working.

All current dust bags, mufflers, filters etc. as supplied with relevant equipment will be used to ensure reduced pollution.

Office Environment

We will where possible reduce consumables within the office environment.

- Paper will be used sensibly
- Paper will be used both sides where possible
- Paper supplies will be from recyclable material
- Use of electronic communication will be used to reduce the need for paper
- Low energy light bulbs will be utilised where possible
- Heating and lighting will only be used whilst the office is in use

All personnel will be made aware of recycling, and all efforts will be made to recycle materials within the office environment.

External Considerations

We will ensure that no polluting matter enters surface waters or groundwater areas, and we will obtain the relevant permission before discharging any contaminated water. Before commencing works and where possible, we will check the area for endangered species, protected plants and trees subject to Tree Preservation Orders and Protected Archaeology.

Sub-Contractors and Suppliers

We will try to use Sub-Contractors and Suppliers who comply with the requirements of our Environmental Management Policy, and will help Sub-Contractors and Suppliers to comply with environmental laws and regulations as much as possible.

We will work closely with all personnel to continually improve and update our procedures.
